Internship information:

- Work to expand the communication of mission, vision and call to action through website and social media.
- Take photographs and/or produce short video for various media and outreach uses.
- Develop a report summarizing information gained through social media and website.
- Produce blog entries and social media posts with guidance from WBA board.
- Develop and research ways to communicate the WBA message.
- Provide 9 hours per week of effort, completing work by May 2015.
- Be responsible for meeting weekly objectives and reporting on these objectives.
- Work on a virtual basis, providing effort at own discretion, using own equipment.
- Assist with various fund raising events.
- Attend monthly meetings and events.

Your background should include:

- The person in this position must enjoy working indoors on a computer but passionate about the importance of open space, backcountry human powered travel and understand the complex nature of land use politics.
- Experience in communication with skills and interest in social media.
- Experience with meeting professional standards of interpersonal, online and written communication.
- Ability to work in a self-motivated and independent manner and innovate to meet work objectives.
- Strong computer skills, including Microsoft Office software. Mapping, GIS and graphic skills helpful.
- Good attitude, sense of humor and ability to speak publicly and personally with our target audience.
